In 2007, upon returning home from a doctoral program at Michigan State University and while serving as a School Psychologist at my alma mater, Beverly J. Martin Elementary School, I inherited this CUMEP leadership role from the founders, my father Mr. Fe Nunn (Ithaca College graduate class of 1980) and my mentor/colleague, Dr. Baruch Whitehead (Ithaca College Full Professor). It is an honor to have the freedom to exercise my *radical Vulnerability* methodology and approach to teaching teachers of all ages. I am energized to establish the CUMEP curriculum and technique as an evidenced-based program because I know this work is replicable. We are confident that with success on our strategic plan and when our glorious aspirations come to fruition, the CUMEP curriculum and technique will positively impact classrooms and communities on both a national and international level.





Our vision is to help every child, artist and teacher spread joy through culture, creativity and teaching community wherever they go. The mission of CUMEP is to empower & uplift children of all walks of life so they can develop self-awareness, academic success and social/civic responsibility through the performing arts.

We are so ready for CUMEP this Summer! CUMEPers who are 7 & older will choose 2 MAJORS.

Campers 6 & under will rotate through the minors (art, music, dance, literacy). This year's camp experience will end with a theatre production, "CUMEP The Musical!" As part of the journey both majors (CUMEPers 7 & up) as well as minors (CUMEPers 6 & under) will be engaged in the history of CUMEP (co-founded by Mr. Fe Nunn & Dr. Baruch Whitehead), the CUMEP Curriculum (created by Dr. Nia Nunn- CUMEP Executive Director) while being introduced to a professional Theatre Education experience (created by Nicole Bethany Onwuka aka "Ms. Nikki Beth"- CUMEP Theatre Director). - Drop-Off is between 7:30 and 8:00 each morning. You will see the CUMEP Operations Manager, Shannon Frier at the gate each morning where you will check in. 
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


